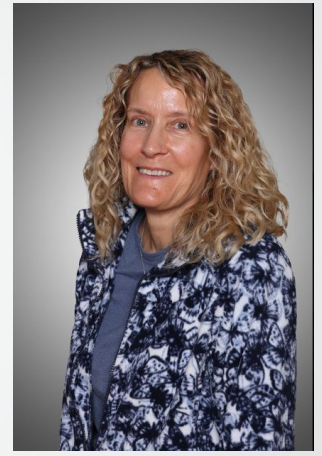

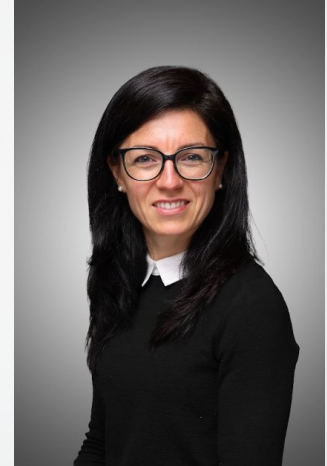

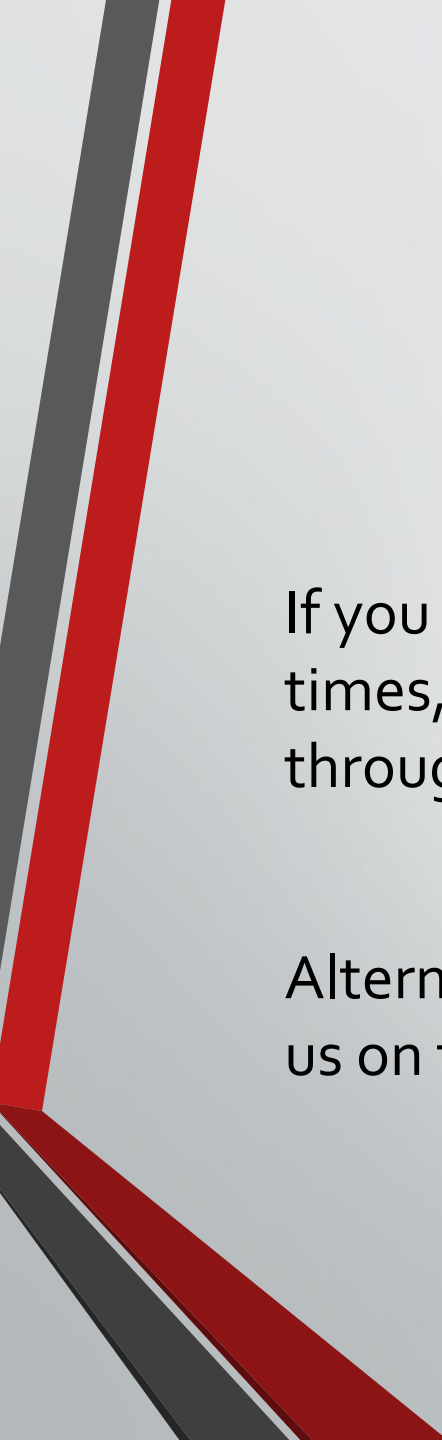

Task 1 - History Who was the Cheddar Man, and what does he tell us about life in prehistoric times? Visit the Natural History Museum website. Record key information that you learn about the Cheddar Man on a mind map.	Task 2 - Maths Learn your 2 and 3 times table at speed. When you are ready, come to the teacher for a speed test.	Task 3 - PE & Sports Create your own warm up activity for a P.E lesson. Make sure it is fun, engaging and involves lots of movement. You will lead your warm up in a P.E lesson.	Task 4 - English Design an imaginary land and write a setting description. Use exciting adjectives.
Task 5 - Art Create an Autumn piece or artwork. For example you could: Do some leaf printing or make a paper plate scarecrow.	Task 6 - History Use information books and the internet to find out about one of these aspects of Stone Age life: settlements, food, clothing, tools and weapons. Use your research to create an information poster about your chosen aspect. Include images and topic-specific vocabulary to make your information poster interesting for the reader	Task 7- Science In Science, we are learning how to keep ourselves healthy. Design a healthy meal for your family. Include all the food groups. Could you try making this meal with the help of your family?	Task 8 - Maths In Year 3, we learn how to use column addition to help us add 2 and 3 digit numbers. Spend some time revising this method.
Task 9 English Year 3 Grammar - Year 3 English - BBC Bitesize Go on to BBC bitesize and create a poster to show your understanding of a noun, verb and adjective.	Task 10 - PSHE Create a body outline of yourself on A4. Decorate your body by listing all your strengths, qualities and any groups you are part of.	Task 11 - Geography Can you learn all seven continents of the world? Here is a song to help you! Seven Continents Song - YouTube	Task 12 - Computing Create a scratch animation https://scratch.mit.edu/
