English

For English, please practice your spellings on a weekly basis. Use the links provided to watch the phonics videos. You will have a weekly spelling test in your phonics group on a Wednesday. As a minimum, pupils should learn the spellings for the given week. However, why not challenge yourself by building sentences using the spellings? We would also like you to read for 10 minutes every day with an adult. Please see the guidance in the front of your reading record.

Maths

Children are expected to know their 2s, 5s and 10s times tables by the end of Year 2. They should be able to recall facts quickly such as $3 \times 5 = 15$. You can use Times Table Rockstars (TTRS) to help them with this (your login is stuck in your reading record), alongside other methods.



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<p>Task 1 - History</p> <p>Choose a British Monarch. Do some research and create a poster or fact sheet about them. Think about the dates they reigned, any significant things they were well known for doing, where they lived etc.</p>	<p>Task 2 - Maths</p> <p>Time - begin developing your time telling skills be reading time to quarter past, half past and quarter to.</p>	<p>Task 3 - PE & Sports</p> <p>Practice bouncing and catching a ball. Can you make the ball bounce then catch it? Can you move while bouncing the ball?</p>	<p>Task 4 - RE</p> <p>Who do you care about? Who cares for you? How do you show that you care for them? Draw a picture and write some sentences about it.</p>
<p>Task 5 - Art</p> <p>Draw a portrait of someone. What pose are they doing? Decide whether to use colouring pencils, paint or something else! Maybe you could make a 3D model.</p>	<p>Task 6 - English</p> <p>In our story, the king bans the darkness. Imagine you no longer have any darkness. Write a diary about what happens and how you feel about it. Don't forget to use capital letters and full stops.</p>	<p>Task 7 - Science</p> <p>Create a food chain. Remember it starts with a plant (the producer), then an animal that would eat the plant (herbivore) and continues with predators.</p>	<p>Task 8 - PSHE</p> <p>Tell us about what you do to help out at home. You could write some sentences, draw a picture or take a photo of you helping out.</p>
