### Maths

For Maths, please practise counting, adding and subtracting up to 20. You could do this on a number line, using your fingers or with counters. Also, you can practise number bonds to 20 (e.g.  $15+5=20$ ,  $1+19=20$ ).

<p><b>Task 1 - Geography</b></p> <p>Take a walk in your local area. What human and physical features can you see?</p>	<p><b>Task 2 - Maths</b></p> <p>Have a go at writing addition and subtraction number sentences up to 10/20. You can also try some where an equals sign is at the front. For example, <math>10 = 5 + 5</math>.</p>	<p><b>Task 3 - PE &amp; Sports</b></p> <p>Play a game of catch with somebody. Can you do an overarm or an underarm throw? You could use a tennis ball or a bean bag.</p>	<p><b>Task 4 - English</b></p> <p>Create your own book cover for your favourite book.</p>
<p><b>Task 5 - Art</b></p> <p>Use objects (e.g. twigs, pebbles, leaves, string, flowers, seeds, lego, play dough) to create a weather picture. You could create a picture of the sun, a rainbow or a cloud for example.</p>	<p><b>Task 6 - Geography</b></p> <p>Have a look at London on Google Earth. What places can you see? Can you spot any landmarks?</p>	<p><b>Task 7- Science</b></p> <p>Look out of your window each day for a week. What is the weather like? Talk to a family member about this.</p>	<p><b>Task 8 - Maths</b></p> <p>Can you count forwards and backwards on a number line to 20? For example, start on 10 and count back 5 spaces. What did you land on?</p>
<p><b>Task 9 - English</b></p> <p>Watch this story. Can you make a family tree? You could draw this or use photos.</p>	<p><b>Task 11 - Science</b></p> <p>Split your page into four and create a picture of the four seasons (Winter, Autumn, Summer, Spring). You could use pencils, paint, pens, crayons or collage.</p>	<p><b>Task 12 - Computing</b></p> <p>Have a go at creating a painting on a device.
