<p><b>Task 1 - Literacy</b> Rosie's Walk <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yvHWqeRzjPo">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yvHWqeRzjPo</a></p> <p>Look at where Rosie walks e.g. over, around, under etc. Use some toys to place under, over, around etc.</p>	<p><b>Task 2 - Maths</b> 10 little Dinosaurs Using some toys to represent the dinosaurs. Listen to the song <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TjmGTbNLj6Q">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TjmGTbNLj6Q</a></p>	<p><b>Task 3 - PE</b> Ask the children to move like dinosaurs.. Ask the children to move around and when you say "The hunters are coming" Your child will then move to a safe place (the sofa or bed)</p>	<p><b>Task 4 - Maths</b> Use some building bricks to have a tower building competition with a grown-up. Which tower has more bricks? Which tower has fewer bricks? What makes you think that? How could you check?</p>
<p><b>Task 5 - Art</b> Look at some spring flowers. Can you draw and paint a picture of the spring flowers.</p>	<p><b>Task 6 - Understanding of the World</b> Look at shadows of different things. Draw around their shadow. Can you see features? Why not. .</p>	<p><b>Task 7- Understanding of the World</b> Build a bug hotel outside using sticks, stones, leaves and moss. Use a digital camera to take photographs of signs of spring. Plant some seeds and talk about what seeds need to grow</p>	<p><b>Task 8 - Maths</b> When playing with building bricks or small toys, encourage your child to count how many of each colour or size.</p>
<p><b>Task 9 Understanding the World</b> Lots of baby animals are born in the spring. Find out the names of these baby animals: duck, pig, sheep, cow and chicken. You could ask a grown-up to help you find the answers on the Internet or in a book.</p>	<p><b>Task 10 - PSED</b> Ask a grown-up to help you create a calm box or calm space in your home for when your emotions are feeling big. Choose things to add to your box or space that help you to feel better when you are feeling worried or angry. You could decorate the box and add photos of special people and special places that you have visited.</p>	<p><b>Task 11 - Communication and Language</b> Play the game 'I Hear with My Little Ear'! Take it in turns to imitate the sound of something and guess what makes that sound. You could imitate the sounds of things found around your house, like a clock or a telephone, or of recognisable animals like a cat or dog.</p>	<p><b>Task 12 - Communication and Language</b> Play 'Follow-the-Leader' with your family. One person chooses some body percussion, such as patting their knees, clapping their hands or clicking their fingers, and the rest of the family have to copy them. Take turns to be the leader.</p>
