

English

Maths

Throughout Year 5, children should continue consolidating their times table knowledge and begin learning the corresponding division facts. Use Times Table Rockstars (TTRS) to help them with this. Your login is stuck in your homework book. Our focus this half term will be written multiplication using column multiplication and the bus stop division method.

They may be on displays, posters, price tags, newspapers... keep your eyes peeled.</p>	<p>Task 3 - PE & Sports</p> <p>Can you run/walk a mile- how long did it take you?
