### English

For English, please practise your phonics on a weekly basis. Encourage your child to continue practising writing their name and the new sounds taught each week.

### Maths

Children are expected to know their number bonds to 10, count up to 20 and subitise (recognise an amount without counting) beyond 5 by the end of Reception. This can be achieved in a variety of ways, such as encouraging your child to count the stairs or recognise numbers all around them.

<p><b>Task 1 - Understanding of the world</b></p> <p>This half term we are looking at world explorers. Please could the children draw a picture of a trip they have been on. If they can use their sounds to label their pictures this would be great.</p>	<p><b>Task 2 - Maths</b></p> <p>Going on a shape hunt in the local environment. What 2d shapes can you find? Can you draw them?</p>	<p><b>Task 3 - Literacy</b></p> <p>To practise your letter formation. To challenge the children can they write their letters on the line.</p>	<p><b>Task 4 - Phonics</b></p> <p>Reading or showing their story book to another member of the family. Can they see any of their set 1 sounds?</p>
<p><b>Task 5 - Communication and language</b></p> <p>Children to share their favourite nursery rhyme, can they share this with their adult using an instrument if they can.</p>	<p><b>Task 6 - Literacy</b></p> <p>To write a shopping list. Can they remember what a list looks like? (one item under another).</p>	<p><b>Task 7 - Physical development fine motor</b></p> <p>Using scissors. Children to cut out a picture trying to have control of the scissors and follow the lines.</p>	<p><b>Task 8 - Physical development gross motor</b></p> <p>Ride their scooter or their bike, Showing control and stopping when asked.</p>
<p><b>Task 9- Personal, social and emotional</b></p> <p>With a grown up, make a fruit salad or smoothie. What fruits can you add? Which one is your favourite and can you try a fruit you haven't eaten before?</p>	<p><b>Task 10 - Communication and language</b></p> <p>To visit a library and choose a non-fiction book.</p>	<p><b>Task 11 - Expressive art and design</b></p> <p>A piece of art work or collage linked to the winter season.</p>	<p><b>Task 12 - Personal, social and emotional</b></p> <p>Challenge yourself to complete a tricky puzzle. Can you persevere like our persevering parrot and continue till you complete it.</p>
