### English

For English, please practise your spellings on a weekly basis. You will have a weekly spelling test, in class, with your teacher on a Wednesday. As a minimum, pupils should learn the spellings for the given week. However, why not challenge yourself by building sentences using the spellings? We would also like you to read for 20 minutes every day. This can be with an adult or independently.

### Maths

Children are expected to know all of their times tables up to 12x12 by the end of Year 4. They should be able to recall facts quickly such as  $3 \times 5 = 15$ . In KS1 your child would have learnt their 2, 5 and 10's. Now start learning your 3, 4 and 8 times tables off by heart. If you know these already, try your 6 and 7 times tables. Use Times Table Rockstars (TTRS) to help them with this. Your login is stuck in your homework book.
