School Uniform Policy

1. Introduction and scope

The school expects all children to wear school uniform, looking neat and tidy and taking pride in their appearance. Parents and Carers are asked to support the school's uniform policy by providing the correct uniform and encouraging children to look after it. We request that you label all items of clothing with your child's name.

2. Our Uniform

We have a summer and winter uniform. Our summer uniform can be worn from the return to school after the Easter break, up until the October half term.

- White Polo Shirt or shirt – Collared.
- Red cardigan, sweatshirt, or jumper with or without the school logo on it.
- Grey or black skirt or pinafore dress
- Grey or black tailored trousers (trousers made of jersey fabric are permitted providing they give the appearance of smart trousers.) Leggings are NOT permitted.
- Grey, black, or white socks
- Grey, black, or white tights
- Black shoes – these should be proper shoes and NOT trainers, crocs or similar.

Summer Uniform.

This can be the above and also:

- Red and White checked dress
- Grey or black knee length tailored shorts.

3. P E Kit

For the days when a pupil has PE, the uniform can be changed for PE kit as follows:

- White t-shirt collared or round neck.
- Black shorts which are suitable for school including in length.
- Trainers – which can be of any colour but must be suitable for PE.
- Black jogging bottoms and a school jumper can be worn in winter for outdoor PE.

4. Jewellery

Apart from one pair of stud earrings (one earring in each ear) no other jewellery should be worn.

The pupil must be able to remove and/or tape over the earring for PE lessons. The school does not take any responsibility for keeping removed jewellery safe.

A watch or Fitbit may be worn as long as the device does not have the ability to take call, photographs, or videos. The school does not take any responsibility for keeping removed watches or Fitbits safe.

5. Hair and Make Up

Hair should be a single natural colour.

For health and safety reasons, long hair should always be tied back.

Any ribbons, slides, hair bands etc. must be red, white, or black and must be of a reasonable size and be secure.

Nail vanish and make up should not be worn at school.
